REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
August 11th, 2021

- Commission approved \$5,000 from the Celebrations and Events budget to the Heritage Society to assist in funding the Farmers and Artisans Market Pavilion at the train station.
- Commission accepted the Auditor’s management letter stating that the audit did not identify any material misstatements, fraud, or illegal acts.
- Commission approved Commissioner Grant’s attendance at the Association of Nova Scotia Villages annual conference in New Minas on September 18th, 2021.
- Commission approved the development of a strategic plan with a call for assistance from Municipal Affairs staff.
- Commission amended the Audit Committee Policy, section 3.0 Committee Composition, “the Committee shall consist of all members of the commission and **TWO** citizen appointments as voting members.”
